The Aquarium

The aquarium is a place where you can see 15 marine animals. Marine animals are animals 25 that live in the water. When you go to an 33 aquarium you can see things like fish, jellyfish 41 or stingrays. You may see small sea animals like starfish and crabs. You may see large 49 58 sea animals like an octopus or a shark. Other 66 animals you may see at the aquarium are turtles or sea otters. 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

Spring

We have four seasons: winter, spring, summer and fall. Spring begins every year on March 21st 16 or  $22^{nd}$ . When spring comes, the weather begins 24 to get warmer and the sun shines longer every 33 day. Many animals, like birds, sheep and cows, 41 have babies in the spring. In the spring, the grass 51 begins to grow, and buds form on trees and 60 flowers. Many animals that hibernate in the 67 winter wake up in the spring.
