## Spring

We have four seasons: winter, spring, summer and fall. Spring begins every year on March $21^{\text {st }}$ or $22^{\text {nd }}$. When spring comes, the weather begins 24 to get warmer and the sun shines longer every day. Many animals, like birds, sheep and cows,
have babies in the spring. In the spring, the grass 51 begins to grow, and buds form on trees and
flowers. Many animals that hibernate in the winter wake up in the spring. You can see frogs, 77 squirrels and chipmunks in the spring. Many birds 85 come out in spring too. Spring is over in June, when it becomes summer!
